## Notes for New Members

On your acceptance to Highfield Golf Club, you will receive a copy of the Club diary. You should also ask at reception for your free copy of The Rules of Golf and The Standard Scratch- Handicapping booklets. You may also order your Club sweater, tee shirt and various other Highfield Merchandise.

You will receive a temporary handicap of 18 if you have never previously held a GUI handicap, this will allow you to participate, immediately, in club competitions. When you have completed and submitted three cards, signed by a Highfield Golf Club Member, you will be allocated an official WHS handicap. These three cards must be from rounds of golf played at Highfield and signed by a Highfield Golf Club member. In the case of Ladies cards are acceptable from other courses once they have been signed by a Golf Ireland member.

To win first prize in any of the three major competitions one should be a playing member on or before October 1st of the previous year and have returned a minimum of two monthly medal or three qualifying competitions in the current season April to September. To be eligible to win a major in the Ladies' Club one should have returned cards in a minimum of three 18 hole competitions from the previous September.

As Golf Ireland members, with an official handicap from Highfield Golf Club, you are eligible to enter Open Competitions in other Clubs and may be asked to represent Highfield in the Inter Club competitions.

Neat dress is expected on the course at all times and we ask members to lead by example. Remember when playing golf outside Highfield you are representing your Club and you should conduct yourself accordingly.

## **Club Match-play**

We would encourage all members to enter the Match-play Competitions. It is a great way to meet other members and to test your golf 'head to head'. The match-play deadline dates are detailed in this diary and in order to complete the competitions in the current season the following rules will apply:-

1. Responsibility lies with the second name(s) drawn in the match to make contact with your opposition to agree a suitable date.
2. If no contact has been made by the deadline, the first name(s) drawn will automatically go through.
3. If either individual/team have a problem with making contact and/or getting the match played please contact the Competition Secretary for a decision.
4. The Competition Secretary's decision will be final.

The trophies to be presented at Captain's Dinner to be held on 22nd October 2022.

## **Club Rules (Men's Club)**

1. Last cards for inclusion in competition must be returned by 6.00pm on the Sunday evening of the weekend competitions.
2. To be eligible to win first prize in any of our Majors (Captain's Prize, President's Prize) you must be a playing member on or before October 1st of the previous year and have returned score cards for a minimum of two monthly medal competitions or three singles competitions within the current season (start date 1st April 2017).
3. Juniors are excluded from winning any of the following competitions, but may be placed:

Captain's Prize, President's Prize, Highfield Masters, Highfield Green Jacket, G.O.Y., Vice Captain's Prize, Hon. Secretary's Prize,

or any of the Monthly Medals. In the event of a junior having the best score in any of the above they will be awarded an appropriate prize.

### **Ladies Club**

1. To be eligible to win first prize in any of our Majors (Lady Captain's Prize, President's Prize) you need to have returned score cards in a minimum of three 18 hole singles competitions from the previous October.
2. Cards should be returned as per competition rules, immediately on completion of your round.

### **Rules of Golf**

Unlike other sports, golf is played without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and abide by the rules. All members should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game we all love.

This means that when you enter a competition, you undertake to play by the Rules of Golf. Free copies of the rules are available in Highfield for all members and any local rules are printed on the back of your scorecard. Ignorance of the rules is no defence.

### **Handicap**

If you break Standard Scratch it is your responsibility to know the reduction that applies to your handicap. This cut in your handicap comes into effect immediately i.e. you must play off your new handicap in any future competitions. If this happens in Highfield your new handicap will be automatically adjusted on the Club Computer. If it happens on

an away course you must ensure that a copy of your card is sent back to Highfield for the attention of the Handicap Secretary.

Alternatively if you score above the Standard Scratch, depending on conditions, your handicap may be adjusted upwards! Similar to a cut in handicap, the increase does come into effect immediately it appears on GolfNet which is generally the day after the event.

Success in Team Events and/or Classics may also result in a reduction in handicap. Again please ensure that any winning cards are returned to the Handicap Secretary.

### **Representing the Course**

When playing in a group please ensure that the Rules of Golf are adhered to. Remember you are representing all other competitors to ensure that everybody 'plays by the rules'.

### **Out of Bounds**

If you are unlucky enough to hit a ball 'out of bounds' you must replay the shot from the original position without gaining distance and you must penalise yourself 1 shot e.g. if your ball lands out of bounds off the tee, you may tee up again from the same position and play your third stroke on that hole.

### **Ground Under Repair**

*Definition: A marked area of the course from which a player is entitled to remove his ball and drop clear, without penalty.*

Typical examples of GUR would include:- work in progress, tree lifting, excavation, construction work, re-sodded areas and damaged areas of the course, including greens. You are entitled to remove your ball, clean it, go to the nearest point of relief (no nearer the hole) and drop it within one club length of your nearest point of relief, again no nearer the hole.

In relation to GUR **no individual or group of players can decide for themselves that a specific area of the course is GUR.** It is the responsibility of the Course / Club that you are playing to make that decision and notify all competitors of same by clearly marking the area and/or advising players through Local Rules /Notice Board. If in doubt play the ball as it lies and no rule will be broken.

### **Club Website**

To keep Members informed of club activities i.e. fixtures, results, notices, socials and photos, we have set up our own website. Using the web the Committee can quickly and easily remind members of important dates.

## Etiquette

Please do not practice your swing on the teeing grounds or while others are preparing to play.

Please do not move, talk or stand directly behind other players while they play their shots.

Please do not play until those in front of you are out of range.

Please play without delay and move on as soon as it is safe to do so.

Players searching for a ball should signal the group behind to pass on, as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found.

Repair plug marks, replace divots, rake bunkers and leave rakes inside the bunkers, where they are least likely to interfere with play.

When on greens, avoid standing on the putting line of your playing partners.

Bring your caddy car to the side or back of the green before putting out, and try to keep it at least five metres from the putting surface, to avoid damage to the green.

Remember your position on the course is directly behind the group in front of you and not in front of the group behind.

The green staff at Highfield take great care to present the course in top condition, so please treat the course with respect and leave it as you would wish to find it.

Please replace rakes in the bunkers.

## The Main New Rules for 2020

### Definitions:

**Penalty Area**- an area from which relief with a 1 shot penalty is allowed (formerly 'Water Hazard'). Still defined as either yellow or red.

**Relief Area**- the area in which the ball must be dropped (and come to rest) when taking relief under a rule.

**Reference Point**- the point from which the size of the Relief Area is measured.

**General Area**- anywhere on the course except Teeing areas, Penalty areas, Bunkers and Greens (formerly 'Through the Green')

**Temporary Water**- formerly 'Casual Water'

### Pace-of-play support

Encouragement of **Ready Golf** in Stroke Play.

Recommended maximum 40 seconds to play a shot.

Reduced search time, alternative to stroke & distance and putting with the flagstick in the hole (see below for more details)

Players may agree to play out of turn in Match Play.

### Elimination of 'Ball Moved' penalties

No penalty for **accidentally moving** a ball on the **putting green** or in **searching** for a ball.

### Relaxed Putting Green rules

No penalty if a ball hits an **unattended flagstick** in the hole.

Players may **repair damage** to the green, whether their ball is on the green or not. This includes old hole plugs, spike marks and damage made by shoes, animals and maintenance practices.

No penalty for **touching the line** of putt.

A ball **resting against the flagstick** is deemed holed as long as part of the ball is below the surface of the ground.

Interference by a **Wrong Green** now includes the player's stance.

## Relaxed Bunker rules

No penalty for **moving loose impediments** (stones, leaves, etc.) in a bunker or for generally **touching the sand** with hand or club (but not directly in front or behind the ball or in making a backswing or practice swing).

An extra relief option for an **unplayable ball**, allowing the ball to be played from outside the bunker with a two stroke penalty.

## Relaxed rules for Penalty Areas

Expanded use of red penalty areas where lateral relief is allowed (used on the 13th hole at MGC).

No penalty for moving loose impediments, touching the ground or water or taking a practice swing in a Penalty Area.

## Simplified way of Taking Relief

New procedure for taking relief by dropping in a specific Relief Area.

Ball dropped from knee height and must stay within the Relief Area.

## Lost Ball & Provisional Ball

A ball is **Lost** if not found within **3 minutes** of commencing search, although a reasonable amount of additional time is allowed to get to and identify a ball that has been spotted within the 3 minutes.

A **Provisional Ball** may be played after the player has moved forward, at any time up to the end of the 3 minute search period.

## Local Rules

Local Rules may change at the discretion of the Committee.

You can find any Local Rules relevant to the current competition, on the Notice Board outside the Clubhouse or on the area beside the computer screen.
